Area Officials See Signs of Economic Growth

On April 16, Bridgeton Area Chamber of Commerce hosted local leaders at Terrigno's Fairfield Inn, as they talked about signs of economic progress across the region. Municipal mayors and the CCIA President

talked about growth in the area, improving the tax base, opportunities for quality jobs, and raising of income levels, all balanced with preservation of our farming industry, and maintaining abundant open spaces we currently enjoy.

Mayor Albert Kelly of Bridgeton said industrial growth including warehousing, cold storage, and cannabis industry, retail development, and new residential development have recently occurred and more is on the drawing boards. He added that the city park and zoo, will see improvements like beautification of the former landfill in the park, new pickleball courts, to serve residents and visitors, whose numbers are growing as they discover the natural beauty and amenities in

the park. New sidewalks, lighting, and trees will be added downtown this spring and summer.

Mayor Robin Freitag of Hopewell Township cited renewal of and continued growth of the township's retail destination, the Greater Bridgeton Amish Market, other retail growth along Shiloh Pike, interest in the town-

ship-owned business park, and the beginning of construction of high speed, broadband internet infrastructure throughout the whole township.

"Thanks to the years of work by former township committee leaders Greg Facemyer and Paul Ritter,
Hopewell is one of the first municipalities in New Jersey to get funding for and to build its own broadband infrastructure to give every household, business, and school the opportunity to purchase high speed internet service. Mayor Freitag echoed Mayor Kelly, about the importance of parks and open space, citing the township's park, including the recently dedicated Hankins Family

Picnic area.

Mayor Jim Crilley and Township Administrator Roy Spoltore of Upper Deerfield pointed to economic growth continuing in the township, particularly along Rt. 77, and at Carlls Corner. Mayor Crilley said a Swedenbased company, SIKA USA, has announced that it will build its U.S. East Coast Anchor facility in Upper Deerfield on over 100 acres they pur-

chased. Construction should begin in July

2024 with as many as 80 new jobs for the area.

He said the benefits of township's large redevelopment zone that includes all infrastructure and rail access, is attracting interest from businesses, including manufacturing, cold storage, and warehousing.

Spoltore talked about residential developments that are approved, under construction, and about to start construction, that will add many units and residents to the area. All of this is balanced with large areas that are permanently preserved for agriculture, and thousands of acres that are zoned for agriculture, and are under cultivation, that should help maintain the township's open spaces and agriculture base.

Lawrence Township Mayor Skip Bowman highlighted growth in his area and talked about the township's redevelopment area that runs along the OmniTrax, Winchester Western railroad. The township owned several hundred acres and in partnership with private owners, they hope to attract warehousing and other development that needs rail service and large lots, but is not reliant on public water and sewer, which the township does not have available at this time.

Deerfield Township Administator Dawn Bascelli, who attended on behalf of Mayor Abigail Perlstein O'Brien, explained the township's economic growth, much coming from long-time existing businesses that are expanding, like F & S Fresh Produce, and the expansion of its agriculture foundation with two active vineyards and wineries, Terra Nonno and Cedar Rose. There has also been growth around the county solid waste complex, which provides a host benefit to the township which helps support the budget. She stressed that Deerfield strives to balance economic growth with maintaining its rural, agriculture-centered lifestyle.

Don Daigle of Charles Schwab, Vineland-Millville, sponsor of the Chamber's April meeting, talks about his business and its investment services. Jerry Velazquez, President and CEO of Cumberland County Improvement Authority, provided a county-wide perspective. He said The Authority continues its role in attracting new business, in managing municipal and county construction projects, and in running a state-of-the-art solid waste and recycling complex.

On May 14, the Chamber's luncheon meeting at Green Olive Restaurant, featured a presentation from James Piccone, Vice President of Rowan College of South Jersey about the ways the college is partnering with businesses to strengthen the workforce, to educate employees, and to retain our young people here. The meeting included a scholarship presentation to Lesly Hernandez, a graduating senior from Cumberland County Technical Education Center. She received \$1,000 cash award to further her education co-presented by the Chamber Foundation, South Jersey Water Conditioning Service, Sungenis Insurance Agency, and Members First Federal Credit Union. This and two other \$1,000 scholarships were presented this year in memory of the late David Wilson and Nancy Sungenis, outstanding Chamber, business, and community leaders.

Piccone explained the college's partnership with Rowan University that allows students and their families to save thousands of dollars in tuition and other fees, while earning a Rowan University degree. Like Lesly Hernandez, many high school students are earning valuable college credits while attending high school. Rowan College of South Jersey also offers education and training with no cost to qualified area businesses or their employees. Employees of Bridgeton Area Chamber member businesses are eligible for discounted education.
