

Sika and Lassonde Pappas **Choose Our Area**

Upper Deerfield Township officials recently visited the construction site of Sika's 250,000 square foot state-of-the-art mortar production plant on Rt. 77 near Big Oak Road. The construction of the \$80 million facility has a completion target date of late 2025. Sika officials and representatives of Stanker & Galetto, the local general contractor led the tour of what Sika

calls its North East Anchor site that is expected to employ 50 people initially with plans for future expansion. The Executive Vice President and Operations Head for the Region Americas will speak at the Bridgeton Area Chamber's January meeting. More information on this meeting will be announced.



Mayor James Crilley of Upper Deerfield announced recently that Lassonde Pappas, Lossonde a food processor of juices, ready-to-drink teas, enhanced waters, isotonics, and cranberry sauces, with a long history here in Cumberland County and a large em-

ployer and contributor to the area's economy, has chosen to build new production facilities here in Upper Deerfield. The investment of approximately \$200 million for the 200,000 sq. ft. facility to be built over an estimated two-year period will replace buildings constructed in the 1920's and 1930's. "This is good news for our Township, County and State, and most importantly for nearly 200 employees, and other people and businesses who rely on their relationships with Lassonde Pappas", said Mayor Crilley. He added, "The Township Committee and other municipal, county and state officials worked with Lassonde Pappas representatives to offer them the incentives that come with building new facilities in the township's redevelopment area."


