

Help Family Businesses Make It to the Next Generation

Terrance K. Resnick, a partner in Resnick Succession Group (formerly Resnick Associates), a nationally recognized business succession, es-

tate planning, and life insurance advisory and implementation planning firm with offices in Philadelphia and Kansas City, was the featured speaker at the Bridgeton Area Chamber's February 25 meeting, noon, at Green Olive Restaurant in Hopewell.



Terrance Resnick talks about Succession Planning on Sept. 25

His presentation started with a warning that only 1/3 of family controlled businesses in the Unites States sur-

vive into the next generation. Terry provided techniques to improve the chances that businesses continue into the future and addressed some of the critical mistakes that are common among successful business owners. He talked about the upcoming January 1, 2026 change in federal tax and how to substantially save tax dollars by proactively planning for the change.

He added that United States Supreme Court decision (Connelly v. United States of America) will cause massive additional taxation for certain business owners depending on the type of Buy-Sell Agreement they have for their companies and how it will be funded.

Terry Resnick's presentation including ideas for assuring the long term continuation of their companies. The importance of legitimate valuations in regard to protecting and transitioning companies as well as massive tax savings, liquidity mistakes that often times cause the loss of millions of dollars, yet could legally be avoided, importance of understanding the specifics of business succession legal documents, and understanding of buy-sell agreements.







Chamber's March 18 **Evening Meeting Celebrates Women Business Leaders**




